The Brain Injury Association of Massachusetts is holding the southeastern version of its annual regional Walk & Roll event at the Buzzards Bay recreation area in Bourne on Saturday, September 24.

The Walk & Roll is a celebration and fundraiser that offers a chance for individuals and teams to support those affected by brain injury, a chance for brain injury survivors to connect with those in their community and a chance to increase brain injury awareness. All of the courses are smooth, paved surfaces.

One participant at this year's Southeast Region Walk & Roll will be Gary Brennan of Cape Cod, who suffered a traumatic brain injury in 2014. He and his wife, Lynne, formed Team G 2.0 for the event.

The Brain Injury Association of Massachusetts offers support and resources to brain injury survivors and their families, prevention programs, education about brain injury and legislative advocacy.
